Funding Sources

The [Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security \(CARES\) Act](#) was passed by the US Congress in late March. This includes the [Paycheck Protection Program](#), which provides small businesses with funds to pay up to 8 weeks of payroll costs including benefits. Funds can also be used to pay interest on mortgages, rent, and utilities.
